SEPTEMBER 2016 DNP, INC SURVEY RESULTS

September 2016 Survey Results: DNP Collaboration

The September 2016 survey aimed to capture data reflecting the collaboration both within and outside of our discipline. We hope that you find the results interesting.

76% of respondents either agreed or strongly agreed that as DNP students they demonstrated collaboration within and outside of the nursing discipline. That leaves 24% that did not believe that they collaborated.

70% of respondents relayed that after graduation they have collaborated directly with another discipline to improve health outcomes.

55% relayed that the discipline they collaborate with most frequently is physicians. That leaves 45% of respondents signaling that they collaborate with disciplines outside of medicine more often in order to improve health outcomes.

Nearly 59% of respondents relayed that they believed that others appreciate the value of inter disciplinary collaboration as much as we do in the nursing profession. Other responses point to 41% believing that other disciplines do not appreciate the value of collaboration.

Only 44% of respondents indicated that they believed that collaboration was an easy process that occurs in all day-to-day activities. This suggests that the majority 56% believe that collaboration is NOT an easy process.

These findings suggest that collaboration is not supported or appreciated by all disciplines and nurses have a wide range of experiences in this regard.




